

Siena Pediatrics Information sheet: COVID/ Coronavirus

In an effort to combat the spread of COVID/Coronavirus, Siena Pediatrics will be screening everyone presenting to the clinic. In addition, the following measures have been implemented to assure safety for our patients and staff:

- 1) Professional cleaning of the facility every evening after business hours.
- 2) Only well check will be seen in the morning through early afternoon.
- 3) Sick visits will be seen in the afternoon after all well visits are completed.
- 4) Rooms are thoroughly cleaned after every visit.
- 5) All staff will be required to wear mask.
- 6) Any patients presenting for evaluation of Covid-19 after possible exposure will be asked to stay in the car until called. Patient will be escorted to the isolation room in the back from a side door and family will have limited contact with the office and staff. Only one family member will be allowed with the child.

If any of the above answers are yes, your child needs to be seen in the afternoon for possible sick visit. No child will be scheduled or seen for a well visit if the child or family has recently been exposed to COVID in the last 14 days.

Our office is continually updating our policies based upon CDC and Department Health and Human Services. At this point, Siena Peds will not be doing COVID testing on asymptomatic children even if exposed. Presently Covid test results are taking on average 14-21 days to return.
